While transfer of credit will reduce the number of credits needed for the Psy.D. degree, it may or may not reduce the time for completion of the doctoral program, depending on the length of time it takes the student to complete dissertation and internship requirements. In 2008-2009, 2009-2010, 2015-2016, 2016-2017, and 2017-2018 a Master degree in psychology reduced the time for completion, in the other academic years it did not.
