DIRECT EDUCATIONAL EXPENSES

Direct educational expenses are charges that are assessed and billed by the Bursar's Office based on a student's enrollment and housing status. These charges, along with estimated indirect educational expenses (outlined on page 2), comprise a student's estimated total cost of attendance or budget. INDIRECT EDUCATIONAL EXPENSES

Indirect educational expenses are those costs a student incurs while in attendance that are *not* billed by the University. These costs are *estimates only* and are factored in when determining a student's estimated total cost of attendance or budget. All information is based on full-time enrollment.

NOTE: Students are eligible for financial aid, including loans, scholarships, and other educational resources not to exceed the budget.

Incoming Students: For purposes of establishing the estimated total cost of attendance, room and board figures for on- and off-campus living are based on double occupancy in Dorms A-F and the Freshman Exclusive Meal Plan. If living with a parent or relative, the budget will not include room and will assume board at the Freshman Exclusive Meal Plan rate.

Returning Students: For purposes of establishing the estimated total cost of attendance, room and board figures for on- and off-campus living are based on double occupancy in the Village and the Premium Meal Plan. If living with a parent or relative, the budget will not include room and will assume board at the Premium Meal Plan rate.

The estimated indirect educational expenses comply with the cost-of-attendance provisions contained within the Higher Education Act of 1965 as amended through October 2008; Section 472.
