Transfer-Out Rates for Full Time, First Year, Degree-Seeking Undergraduates

The four-year average Student Right-to-Know transfer-out rate is 33%. This is based on the total number of students who entered the University in the fall terms 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015 (n=5,184) as full time, first year, degree-seeking undergraduate students who did not earn their degree at the University and who were known to have transferred to another institution (n=1,686).
