### **Using Blackboard's Equation Editor**

# Equation Editor Overview

Whenever you add an item to any Content Area, you have the option of including an equation within the space that has been traditionally designated as text (see below).

# Adding an Equation

To add an equation, do the following

- 1. Click the Math Editor symbol within the textbox options (circled above).
- 2. The Formula Editor opens.



3. Enter a name for your equation within the "Equation Name" textbox.

- 4. Use the templates to create formulas or expressions (see circled area above).
- 5. Click **Submit** to finish and close the Formula Editor.

### Constructing an Equation

1. Your first step to adding an equation is to select a formula or expression template from the toolbar (circled below).

2. Each template contains blank spaces represented by squares.



Blank square placeholders for numbers

- 3. The equation template circled above allows you to create a variable with an exponent such as  $X^3$
- 4. To add an equation template, click on it and it will paste the template into the equation editor.
- 5. Click on an empty box in the equation editor to type in a value.
- 6. To move to the next available space, press the right ( $\rightarrow$ ) arrow key.
- 7. Continue inserting formula or expression templates until your desired equation or statement is completed.
- 8. Click **Submit** to finish.

# Modifying an Equation

- 1. Highlight the equation in the text editor.
- 2. Click the **Math Editor** symbol in the text editing area (see below).

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- 3. The equation now appears within the Equation Editor.
- 4. Edit as needed.
- 5. Click **Submit** to save your changes.
