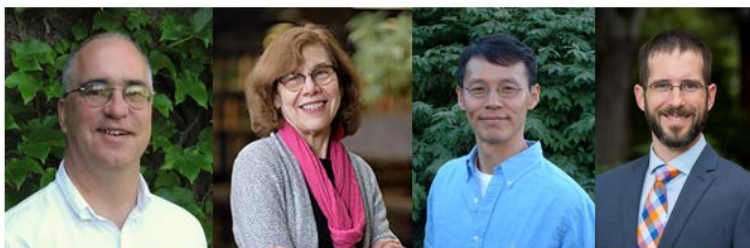
Shirley McLoughlin, Ph.D.

Dr. Shirley Wade McLoughlin, Professor of Education and Affiliate Faculty of Women and Gender Studies at Keene State College, talks about her experiences as a Fulbright Scholar.

Dr. McLoughlin was a 2013 Fulbright Scholar at Iacob Gogebashvili Telavi State University in the Republic of Georgia. Her work there included teaching masters and doctoral courses, conducting seminars with junior and senior English language majors, and presenting at a conference for teachers of English. Her Fulbright work aligned closely with her previous scholarly research, which focused on race in the United States and later broadened to examining cultural components of power in differing societies, and the role education plays in this area.

Dr. McLoughlin earned her doctorate in educational leadership from Miami University of Ohio and has worked in higher education for fourteen years. Prior to this, she worked in public and private schools, teaching kindergarten, second grade, and music. She also worked as a registered nurse, focusing primarily on maternal child health nursing.
