The Tonkin, Larsen, and Trachtenberg Awards are among the most prestigious awards given to faculty by the University and as such reflect the contributions made by exceptional individuals from the various colleges that make up the University of Hartford. The three awards are intended to honor full-time University of Hartford faculty members at commencement each year. Each recipient will receive a University medal, citation, and recognition in the commencement program.

Please take a few minutes upon receipt of this memorandum to review the requirements closely. To be eligible for one of the awards, the nominee must:

- be a full-time faculty member who has been awarded tenure
- a faculty member on an extended temporary contract who has been through a tenure-like review
- a full-time faculty member with a non-tenure track contract with at least six consecutive years of employment

Faculty who were nominated in prior years may be re-nominated. A new nomination, complete with all supporting up-to-date materials, must be submitted.

Nominations may come from a Dean, Department Chair, colleagues or self. While it is feasible for a single individual to nominate and organize the necessary supporting materials for a nominee, a small group of individuals who support the same nominee may work together in the collection and presentation of supporting materials. Criteria for each award and a description of requested supporting documents is included in this packet, and also available at the Faculty Senate website Senate Business and Resources - University of Hartford

Officers of the Faculty Senate cannot be nominated for the awards while they are serving in office.

Nominators are required to submit a complete set of materials for each nominee. Packets will be submitted to the committee exactly as they are received. For all awards, letters from nominators should clearly describe the most significant accomplishments of the nominee, as related to the specific award criteria.

Completed nomination packets for each of the three awards must be hand-delivered to the Faculty Senate Office, CC 314 (Attention: Awards \& Nominations Committee) or emailed as one complete PDF file to the Faculty Senate Office (facsenate @hartford.edu) by 4 p.m., Friday, February 16, 2024. The Humphrey Tonkin Award honors a full-time University of Hartford faculty member for scholarly and/or artistic creativity. This award is named for former President of the University of Hartford and Director of the President's College: Humphrey Tonkin. It succeeds the Bent award and is given each year to a faculty member who has displayed unusual creativity and innovation in the pursuit of scholarship.

The following documentation must be submitted to the committee for review:

- Nomination form (see attached)
- The candidate's curriculum vitae
- Up to four letters of support from colleagues within the University, and up to four from external colleagues. These letters should address how the nominee's scholarship or creative works have contributed to the discipline or field of study and speak specifically to the work(s) that are considered the most important. All letters must address the intent of the award; letters written for other purposes (i.e. promotion and tenure) are not appropriate
- Documentation of quality

Obtain from the nominee, or ask the nominee to include documentation in her/his CV, the indicators of quality noted in the call (e.g., peer reviewed publications, acceptance rejection rates, jury information for exhibits/competitions, commissioned works, copies of reviews for performances, invited presentations, reviews of the nominee's book or monograph, etc.).

The committee will invite one nominator per candidate to attend a meeting and support the nomination with a 10 -to 15 -minute presentation and brief question/discussion period.

The Roy E. Larsen Award honors a full-time University of Hartford faculty member for excellence in teaching and contributions to University life. The award was established in 1979 in memory of the late Roy E. Larsen, former president of Time, Inc., who was a passionate environmentalist and education advocate.

The criteria include excellence in the classroom, interest in/impact on the academic success of students, and contributions to University life. The following documents must be provided for consideration of the nominee:

- Nomination form (see attached)
- The candidate's curriculum vitae
- Up to four letters of support from colleagues within the University, and up to four from external colleagues*
- Up to six letters of support from alumni or former students (who no longer attend the University)*
- Evidence of Teaching Effectiveness as outlined in the FPM and Faculty Data Sheet:

1. Teaching Philosophy
2. Summary Statement: Use this statement to help the reader understand how the following multiple points of evidence connect to your teaching philosophy and/or important aspects of your teaching.
3. Multiple points of evidence - these must support teaching effectiveness and must include some or all of the following:
a. Artifacts of teaching (syllabi, assignments, instructional materials)
b. Outside perspectives (student course evaluations, peer observations, chair observations)
c. Student outcomes (examples of student work, evidence of students' accomplishments, assessment data)
d. Example of utilizing feedback to make improvements in teaching
e. Teaching awards
f. Evidence of innovation
g. Other evidence
4. Professional development related to teaching (optional)
5. Other actives related to teaching (optional)
*Note: All letters must address the intent of the award; letters written for other purposes (i.e. promotion and tenure) are not appropriate.

The committee will invite one nominator per candidate to attend a meeting and support the nomination with a 10 -to 15 -minute presentation and brief question/discussion period.

The Oscar and Shoshana Trachtenberg Award honors a full-time University of Hartford faculty member for sustained service to the University. It is given in memory of Oscar and Shoshana Trachtenberg and is intended to recognize exemplary service and dedication to the concerns of the University, and a willingness to participate fully in University life.

Nominations must include:

- Nomination form (see attached)
- The candidate's curriculum vitae
- Documentation of nominee's sustained service to the University (i.e. Description of service, official role and significant accomplishments)
- Up to four letters of support from colleagues within the University, and up to four from external colleagues. Note: All letters must address the intent of the award; letters written for other purposes (i.e. promotion and tenure) are not appropriate

The committee will invite one nominator per candidate to attend a meeting and support the nomination with a 10 -to 15 -minute presentation and brief question/discussion period.
