### **Shared Governance- Revisiting AAUP Policies in the Wake of COVID and Looking Forward**

Dr. Mulvey will address the AAUP Advocacy Chapter of the University of Hartford to discuss the importance of shared governance, faculty involvement in personnel decisions, selection of administrators, preparation of the budget, and determination of educational policies.

She will contextualize shared governance in the wake of COVID and how changes in higher education can, do, and should involve faculty voice.

Dr. Mulvey is a professor of mathematics at Fairfield University, where she has worked since 1985. She is current AAUP National President. She has served multiple terms as president of the Faculty Welfare Committee/AAUP, Fairfield's AAUP chapter, in addition to serving as president of the Connecticut AAUP conference. She has also served multiple terms as treasurer for both her chapter and the state conference, and was elected by the Council to serve on the AAUP's Executive Committee three times. She is currently a member of the AAUP's Committee A on Academic Freedom and Tenure, for which she will continue to serve ex officio.
