As a Red Cap, you will have the opportunity to work closely with the University's faculty and staff in an informal setting.

## **Red Cap Application Information & Timeline**

*Important Information-please read the following carefully*

- A. Red Caps must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 by the end of the Spring 2023 semester. Red Caps who drop below the grade requirement after being hired for the position may be terminated from their position.

- C. Applications must be submitted via e-mail to [redcap@hartford.edu](mailto:redcap@hartford.edu) no later than Wednesday February 15<sup>th</sup> 2023 by 2:00 PM.

- E. Applicants who are selected to be a part of the 2023 Red Cap team must be available for all Training & Orientation dates beginning June 2023 and ending late August 2023. See "Orientation Timeline" below for specific dates.
- F. Red Caps are paid a total of \$650.00 split into two pays (\$475.00 after sessions 1 through 4, and \$175.00 after session 5 & Start-Strong).
